Associate Professor Allan leads the Mental Health Alcohol and other Drugs Branch in Queensland Health which is the key agency for policy, service development, clinical and legislative governance and information management. He has previously been Chief Psychiatrist in both Queensland and New South Wales. He spent twenty years working in North Queensland where he helped a community recover from a traumatic psychiatric scandal, led clinical services and developed a wide range of new mental health services. He is highly experienced in government policy, mental health legislation and service development.

His clinical interests include the mental health and wellbeing of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and comprehensive care for those with serious mental illness. His current research and policy interests focus on mental health reform, alternatives to coercive practices, human rights, recovery-oriented practice, and smoking reduction strategies.

Associate Professor Allan has been heavily involved in College activities for 25 years leading initiatives in training, education, rural and international medical graduate issues and a Board member for 6 years. He leads a number of presidential priorities as well as the College Covid-19 response.
