Born in the United States, Martha Kane Savage is also a New Zealand citizen, and is Professor of Geophysics at Victoria University of Wellington. In 2017 her son died in a Japanese psychiatric hospital after being restrained near-continuously for 10 days, and she has since campaigned for an end to the practice. She is an Honorary member of the WPA and has served on the WPA Service Users and Family Carers Advisory Working Group, on the Task Force on Minimising Coercion in Mental Health Care and on the Working Group on Volunteering.
