

WPA PSYCHOANALYSIS IN PSYCHIATRY SECTION

DESCRIPTION AND GOALS:

The WPA "Psychoanalysis in Psychiatry" (PIP) Section officially began in 2002, finding its place as one of seventy-two WPA sections, after a long process coordinated by Daniel Simon Kipman (France). The aims of the section/study group are to explore how psychoanalysis may enrich daily clinical practice of psychiatry and provide a forum for interdisciplinary trans-theoretical discussions. Section members study links between theory and practice of psychodynamic psychiatry, neuroscience, social sciences, the humanities, and clinical research.

The "Psychoanalysis in Psychiatry" section concerns itself with:

- The dissemination of psychoanalytic theory to psychiatrists and other expert mental health clinicians.
- The promotion of discussion of the role and function of psychoanalysis in psychiatry, medicine, and healthcare in general. A particular emphasis is placed so that discussion might be functional and integrated in psychiatric practice and/or in fields of health.
- The creation of links with different fields of research within psychiatry itself and also other fields such neuroscience, sociology, anthropology, philosophy, literature, linguistics, aesthetics and the arts, for transdisciplinary study and enlightenment.
- Providing psychiatrists and mental health clinicians worldwide with opportunities to advance psychoanalytic and psychodynamic psychotherapy competency and performance through educational activities.

The Section organizes educational seminars/workshops (in different countries), and symposia panel presentations held at WPA congresses. It also makes available a list of journal articles and book publications. The Section maintains a Newsletter made available to all on the WPA website (see links below).

The PIP Section is open to all psychiatrists interested in Psychodynamic Psychiatry and Psychoanalysis, regardless of level of training or certification. It welcomes trainees and early career psychiatrists as well as seasoned academics and scholars worldwide.

The WPA-PIP Section works in active collaboration with other psychoanalytic and psychodynamic organizations affiliated with the WPA, such as the AAPDPP (American Academy of Psychodynamic Psychiatry and Psychoanalysis), the WADP (World Association of Dynamic Psychiatry), IFP (International Federation for Psychotherapy) and ALFAPSY (Alternative Federative des Associations de Psychiatrie), among others.
