



## Voting Allocation

The table below, which is taken from the WPA By-Laws, shows how votes are allocated to Member Societies. The number of votes allocated to each Member Societies depends on the number of Members declared in the Voting Strength Confirmation Form sent out by the Secretariat before the General Assembly.

The mean yearly membership of Member Society for the three years between WPA General Assemblies is used for the calculation.

## Membership Dues

The table below shows how membership dues are calculated.

If a Member Society has more than 6000 members then they will pay 100% of their allocated dues for their first 6000 members and then 20% of their allocated dues for the number of members above 6001.
