**Position: Secretary for Finances and Fundraising
World Psychiatric Association (WPA)**

To the WPA Electoral Committee and Distinguished Members of the World Psychiatric Association,

My journey within the WPA began in 2017 as an Early Career Psychiatrist (ECP), and since then, I have had the privilege of serving our association in multiple capacities across my region and at the international level. Today, I offer my experience, my institutional knowledge of the WPA, and my proven organizational skills to take on the critical role of ensuring the financial sustainability and growth of our association.

A Decade of Dedicated Service to the WPA

My relationship with the WPA is not one of a passive member but of an active, engaged leader. Over the past eight years, I have built a deep understanding of the WPA's structures, challenges, and immense potential.

My commitment is reflected in a series of concrete achievements:

- **Organizational Leadership:** I have successfully led major international congresses that brought together psychiatrists from across the globe. I know firsthand that a strong financial foundation is not merely about numbers; it is the bedrock that enables every other WPA activity, from educational programs and scientific sections to advocacy and support for early career psychiatrists.

The WPA is at a pivotal moment. To continue leading global psychiatry, we must diversify our funding sources, strengthen partnerships with international organizations, and ensure that our resources are allocated equitably to support our members across all zones, particularly in low- and middle-income regions.

My Vision for the Role

If elected as Secretary for Finances and Fundraising, I will focus on three core priorities:

1. Diversifying Funding Sources: I will work to expand the WPA's donor base beyond traditional sources. This includes developing strategic partnerships with international health organizations (WHO, UN agencies), philanthropic foundations, and the private sector, while ensuring that all partnerships align with the WPA's ethical principles and scientific independence.

2. Strengthening Regional Equity: Having served as a Zonal Representative from Northern Africa, I am acutely aware of the financial barriers that psychiatrists from certain regions face in accessing WPA activities. I will advocate for increasing the dedicated funds to support congress participation and educational initiatives in underserved areas.

3. Enhancing Financial Transparency and Sustainability: I will bring my organizational experience to ensure that the WPA's financial management remains transparent, accountable, and strategically aligned with the association's long-term goals. This includes supporting the EC in developing sustainable revenue models that reduce dependency on any single source of income.

Conclusion

I am not seeking this position to add a title to my CV. I am seeking it because I believe in the WPA. This association welcomed me as an early career psychiatrist and provided me with the platform to grow, to lead, and to contribute. I now wish to give back by applying my organizational expertise, my deep knowledge of the WPA's structures, and my commitment to financial stewardship to serve our global community.
